### Important Township Ordinances

**Snow:** Do not place, cast, or throw snow on any Township streets.

**Burning:** Fires of only paper and/or wood must be contained in a grill, chiminea, or fire ring. Open fires must be kept at least 15' away from any road or structure. Do not burn any construction debris, cardboard, or leaves.

**Garbage:** Place garbage at the curb after 6:00pm on the day prior to pickup. Normal pickup day is Friday beginning at 6:00am.

**Electronics Recycling:** The PA Covered Device Recycling Act of 2010 now prohibits the disposal of electronic devices such as computers, monitors, printers, televisions, speakers, and battery backups. These devices will not be picked if left at the curb. Most electronics retailers accept devices for recycling. **Dogs:** Dogs must be on a leash when being walked. All dogs must be licensed through Allegheny County. Applications are available at the Township Building.

**Overnight parking:** Parking on Township streets between 2:00am and 6:00am is prohibited unless granted permission from the Police Department, or in the case of an emergency.

**Littering:** Do not deposit junk, garbage, or refuse on streets, private, public or vacant grounds, or streams within the Township.

### Armstrong Park

--Open dawn to dusk--

Residents can rent the pavilion or gazebo for a modest fee. Forms are available at the Township Building.

Alcoholic beverages, dogs and other animals, firearms, air rifles, and BB guns are prohibited in the park.

### Hall Rental

--Available Saturday & Sunday--

Residents and nonresidents can rent the upper floor of the Township Building for a modest fee.

The hall accommodates up to 75 and has a kitchen for food preparation and storage.

Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.

## Building Inspection & Permits

Contact the Township Building Inspector before performing any work to verify the need for a permit. The building inspector is available each Wednesday 1:00-4:00pm. Contact the Township to schedule an appointment (412) 341-9597.

### Building permits may be required when:

- Adding a room, dormer, second floor or garage.
- Building or replacing a deck or porch.
- Replacing or constructing a new concrete or asphalt driveway; or changing surface material.
- Adding a parking pad to a driveway.
- Building or replacing a fence.
- Installing an in-ground swimming pool or an above-ground swimming pool with a filter pump.
- Constructing or replacing a shed.
- Making structural alterations to a building or home.
- Excavating, grading, or filling property.
- Replacing or repairing roof structure.

### Building permits are not needed when:

- Replacing siding with new siding.
- Reparing a driveway (no change in size).
- Replacing windows (no change in size).
- Replacing entry doors (no change in size).
- Minor interior repairs.
- Replacing furnace or hot water heater.
- Reshingling an existing roof.

Plumbing permits are required and are available from Allegheny County Health Department (412) 687-2243 or [www.achd.net](http://www.achd.net)

Permits are required for electrical work and are available from the Building Inspector.
