## MINUTES of the Regular Meeting of the Township Commissioners August 3, 2021 7:00 p.m.

Roll call found Commissioners Downey, Fredrick, Frisoli, Pellegrino and Taylor present. Also present were Manager Nina Belcastro, Engineer Glenn Jonnet and Solicitor Tom McDermott.

### Committee Reports:

1. **Administration & Finance – Ms. Frisoli, Chairperson;** Ms. Frisoli reported that everything falls into place. This is our first in-person meeting since the beginning of COVID, and we will continue to monitor the situation.
2. **Public Safety – Mr. Downey, Chairperson;** Mr. Downey read the report along with a letter of commendation from a resident regarding Officer Fry.
3. **Public Works – Mr. Pellegrino, Chairperson;** Mr. Pellegrino read the report.
4. **Sanitary Sewers & Storm Water Management/MS4 – Mr. Taylor, Chairperson –** Mr. reported that with the usage of the SHACOG vac truck, BTPW was able to coordinate the cleaning of all catch basins in the Township. Taylor deferred to Mr. Jonnet for further comment. Mr. Jonnet reported that we are still waiting on the Consent Order.
