**MINUTES of the Pre-Agenda Meeting of the Township Commissioners
Monday, February 25, 2019
7:00 p.m.**

Commissioner Frisoli called the meeting to order at 7:13 pm.

Roll call found Commissioners Allen, Downey, Frisoli and Snyder present. Also present were Township manager Nina Belcastro, Solicitor Tom McDermott, and Engineer Glenn Jonnett.

Points of Discussion:

1. **Township engineer presented findings on water runoff at Dewalt. A natural valley has been created, which is potentially causing flow towards 406 and 404 Dewalt. A dry pond could potentially create a solution to this problem. We will need to acquire an easement on those properties that have created said natural trenches. Water hits straight at 414 Dewalt – they have created a diversion ditch to avoid the massive amount of water, which ultimately lands at 406 Dewalt. Potential solutions include: a dry pond or rain garden.**

\$10k grant for rain garden – due March 29th

2. Township Parking Ordinance and enforcement
 - a. Winter Storm Parking
3. ALOM Conference

Manager's Report:

PW employees will be acquiring the following licenses and certifications over the next few months: CDL Licensing – driving sewer truck by May, Dave – pesticide class, April, Gabe – various – DB will help coordinate.

Question regarding Police Access to public works garage and using misc. supplies without public works permission/acknowledgment. Manager and Board agree that this is unacceptable and police officers need to have permission prior to entering and/or using any garage materials.

Solicitor's Report: Solicitor read his report.

Engineer's Report: Edgewood outfall no longer exists – Castle Shannon removed and replaced Baldwin Township outfall and pipes. Manager with talk with PW Supervisor about same.
