Roll call found Commissioners Downey, Fredrick, Frisoli, McCabe and Pellegrino present. Also present were Manager Nina Belcastro, Engineer Glenn Jonnet and Solicitor Tom McDermott.

Magisterial Judge David Barton administered the Oath of Office to Commissioner Jamie McCabe. A copy of her oath of office was left with the township manager.

### Committee Reports:

1. **Administration & Finance – Ms. Frisoli, Chairperson;** Ms. Frisoli reported that she looked over everything falls into place.
2. **Public Safety – Mr. Downey, Chairperson;** Mr. Downey read the report and added that Officer Krek returned to work on 2/8/22.
3. **Public Works – Mr. Pellegrino, Chairperson;** Mr. Pellegrino read a memo commending the work of PW Foreman, David Bowers and then read the report
4. **Sanitary Sewers & Storm Water Management/MS4 – Ms. Frisoli –** Ms. Frisoli deferred to Mr. Jonnet. Mr. Jonnet reported that he received the ALCOSAN model file, but we are still waiting on the Rt. 88 section. There is a meeting coming up regarding the Consent Order.
