Committee Reports:

- 1. Administration & Finance – Ms. Frisoli, Chairperson;** Ms. Frisoli reported that everything falls into place. Protocols are being followed and we are closely monitoring the situation. We ended up NOT needing to transfer funds from the sewer fund. Also, the Auditors should be in around mid-June for the annual audit.
- 2. Public Safety – Mr. Downey, Chairperson;** Mr. Pellegrino read the report.
- 3. Public Works – Mr. Pellegrino, Chairperson;** Mr. Pellegrino read the report.
- 4. Sanitary Sewers & Storm Water Management/MS4 – Mr. Taylor, Chairperson –** Mr. Taylor deferred to Mr. Jonnet. Mr. Jonnet reported that he sat in on the last Consent Order meeting. The Order is pretty much finalized. Baldwin Township received new EPA requirements. We may have to amend our Ordinance, unless there is something in the Consent Order that covers this issue.
