Commissioner Frisoli called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm and asked that the group stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call found Commissioners Fredrick, Frisoli, Pellegrino and Taylor present. Also present were Manager Nina Belcastro, Police Chief Terry O'Brien, Engineer Glenn Jonnet and Solicitor Tom McDermott.

Remarks from audience:

Chief O'Brien introduced the Township's newest police officer, Tyler Maceiko. Officer Maceiko was welcomed by the Board.

Committee Reports:

1. **Administration & Finance – Ms. Frisoli, Chairperson;** Ms. Frisoli reported that everything falls into place. Protocols are being followed and we are closely monitoring the situation.
2. **Public Safety – Mr. Downey, Chairperson;** Mr. Pellegrino read the report.
3. **Public Works – Mr. Pellegrino, Chairperson;** Mr. Pellegrino read the report.
4. **Sanitary Sewers & Storm Water Management/MS4 – Mr. Taylor, Chairperson –** Mr. Taylor deferred to Mr. Jonnet. Mr. Jonnet reported that the Township will need to put our next sewer lining project out to bid in the very near future.
5. **Parks & Recreation – Ms. Frisoli & Mr. Taylor –** Upcoming events are pending, but we are working on bringing a few food trucks to the Township this summer.

7. **SHACOG – Ms. Fredrick & Ms. Frisoli, co-Chairs –** Ms. Frisoli reported that meetings are still being held over Zoom. Salt prices through the SHACOG contract have not changed for the upcoming year.
8. **Fire Company – Ms. Fredrick, Chairperson –** Ms. Fredrick reported: CSVFD is hosting a food truck fest in the fire hall parking lot on June 20.

9. **MRTSA – Mr. Downey & Mr. Pellegrino, Chairperson;** Mr. Pellegrino reported that Dormont has taken over with Presidency. There have been new committee assignments and a new committee created to focus on community outreach. The search for the new executive director continues.
