## MINUTES of the Public Meeting of the Township Board of Commissioners March 8, 2022

Commissioner Frisoli called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and asked that the group stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call found Commissioners Downey, Fredrick, Frisoli, McCabe and Pellegrino present. Also present were Manager Nina Belcastro, Police Chief Terrence O'Brien, Engineer Glenn Jonnet and Solicitor Tom McDermott.

Commissioner Downey and Chief O'Brien introduced the Township's newest police officer – Officer Renjenico (Nick) Manday.

### **Remarks from audience:**

Township resident Dave Brazelton raised a concern regarding water runoff in the area of Robertson Road and Klein Place. Mr. Brazelton feels that the amount of water has increased dramatically over the last year. Manager and Engineer explained that both the PW Supervisor and Engineer examined the area. The water is likely caused by the dramatic weather patterns (specifically, the freeze-rain pattern) that have taken place recently, preventing the water to be absorbed as it normally would. Mr. Brazelton asked whether the current construction on Klein Place could be causing the water. Mr. Jonnet explained that the new development has undergone extensive stormwater management and will increase erosion controls and SWM in the area. The developer is currently installing controls that will exceed TMDL requirements. Engineer agreed to look at the area again to see if he come to any further conclusions.

### **Committee Reports:**

1. **Administration & Finance – Ms. Frisoli, Chairperson;** Ms. Frisoli reported that she looked over everything falls into place.
2. **Public Safety – Mr. Downey, Chairperson;** Mr. Downey read the report and added that our new officer started on 2/28/22
3. **Public Works – Mr. Pellegrino, Chairperson;** Mr. Pellegrino read the report.
4. **Sanitary Sewers & Storm Water Management/MS4 – Ms. McCabe, Chairperson –** Ms. McCabe deferred to Mr. Jonnet. Mr. Jonnet reported that there is a Phase 2 Consent Order meeting coming up. He is working on issues surrounding the proposed Exhibit B.

5. **Parks & Recreation – Ms. Fredrick, Ms. McCabe & Ms. Frisoli** – Manager Belcastro discussed the upcoming DCED grant application. If awarded, funds will be used to repair and revitalize Armstrong Park.
6. **Lights & Transportation – Mr. Downey Chairperson** –Mr. Downey – Nothing to report at this time.
7. **SHACOG – Ms. Fredrick & Ms. Frisoli, co-Chairs** – Ms. Frisoli reported that the last meeting took place in Whitehall. They are beginning to collect information on the upcoming garbage contract.
8. **Fire Company – Ms. Fredrick, Chairperson** – Ms. Fredrick read the monthly fire callout report and also reported that glass recycling is available at Memorial Hall. Tuesday night bingo continues and is going well. The purse bash is scheduled for 4/24/22 and the ladies flea is scheduled for 5/14/22. CSVFD will be celebrating its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary in May, with events being scheduled on May 21 and 22.
9. **MRTSA – Mr. Downey & Mr. Pellegrino, Chairperson;** Mr. Downey reported that things are going very well. The Chief and Executive Director are working well together and keeping everything on the right track. Mr. Pellegrino reported that all new equipment is coming in.
