Roll call found Commissioners Downey, Fredrick, Frisoli, McCabe and Pellegrino present. Also present were Manager Nina Belcastro, Police Chief Terrence O'Brien, Solicitor Michail DeLorenzo and Engineer Glenn Jonnet.

### **Committee Reports:**

1. **Administration & Finance – Ms. Frisoli, Chairperson;** Ms. Frisoli reported that she looked over everything for the month of August and everything falls into place. Jordan Tax Service is doing very well with tax collection.
2. **Public Safety – Mr. Downey, Chairperson;** Mr. Downey read the report.
3. **Public Works – Mr. Pellegrino, Chairperson;** Mr. Pellegrino read the report.
