**MINUTES of the Pre-Agenda Meeting of the Township Commissioners
Monday, April 24, 2023
7:00 p.m.**

Commissioner Frisoli called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Roll call found Commissioners Downey, Fredrick, Frisoli, McCabe and Pellegrino present. Also present were Manager Nina Belcastro, Solicitor Michael DeLorenzo and Engineer Glenn Jonnet

Points of Discussion:

1. Event Planning Committee – Commissioner Fredrick will be heading the new committee, which will be reported monthly at all regular meetings. After brief discussion, it was decided that the Event Planning Committee will be independent from the parks and Rec Committee and will be made up of Baldwin Township residents and at least one commissioner.

Engineer's Report:

Engineer reported that the flow isolation study was discussed at the last 3RWW meeting. Engineer noted that the Township might not actually have 10% of flow to reduce (as required), so we will have to discuss that when it comes time to report.

The Robertson Road specs and RFP will be coming out in the very near future. Engineer is working with Manager and Solicitor.

Due to the ongoing utility repairs, Engineer discussed the benefits of holding off on much of the road paving program for 2023. The Robertson Road and hillside remediation project will move forward as planned. However, due to the uncertainty of location for upcoming utility repairs, the Township should consider putting the remainder of the road paving program on hold for 2023.

Engineer met with an environmental company regarding possible funding for the potential stream project on McNeilly Road. They will be submitting a proposal with further details.

Lastly, we are still waiting on PWSA to formally agree to the TMDL reduction credit project. Engineer will update the Board.
